Actions from last site visit: Remain as per the last 2 monitoring visit as well as the update comments.

- Height of site stockpiles to be maintained to their designated heights. Update: Kept on record as reminder.
- Stockpiling area only to be used for stocking purposes. Update: Still outstanding. Use
 of the land for screening purposes requires either to be regularised or for the
 machinery/plant to be removed.
- Tidying up of the plant/machinery parts located within the stockpiling area and concrete batching plant locations. **Update:** Accumulations of redundant plant/machinery and odd items still stored in various points around site.
- Demarcating boundary of aftercare/active as per the Plan B7m/178. **Update: No action taken.**
- Measures to address tree planting along northern site boundary. Update: BA
 confirmed from internal discussions that tree planting was undertaken by operator
 outside of planning control requirements. Monitoring consideration result Unlikely
 further initiatives likely to address the establishment of trees on this boundary.

Inspection Results Summary:

• Site bellmouth clean at time of visit.

- Stored portacabin remains in car park and earmarked for replacing existing toilet block. This portacabin has remained insitu awaiting its commissioning over a number of the previous monitoring visit periods. Existing portacabins still in use. Redundant portacabin still to be removed off site.
- Rear of offices still accommodating various items though not as many as previous.
- Lagoon nearest highway remains active with about three quarters filled with silt
 exposed at surface and with the silt drying out within eastern end and appears to be
 at a raised level vegetation establishing on periphery.
- Area of restored land remains in grass. Cover has been cut and growth low to ground.
- Transplanted trees/whips along northern edge already reported on above.
- Perimeter bunding significant weed growth around site perimeter.
- Southern end of former extraction void now mostly backfilled and grading down to future lake profile.
- Main extraction area quiet. One ADT parked up alongside hopper which was full but conveyor not operating during time of visit.
- Water in base of void appears from water marks on banking to have dropped from previous levels. Algal growth apparent within the northern end of water body. Sand Martin nests visible top of eastern side of basal void face.
- Stockpile of sand on first bench above water. Appears this western area still being extracted whilst extraction is taking place rather haphazardly to the east in the revised phasing 6 location. Here mineral has been removed from northern fenceline/tree line with slopes at/above 45 degrees whilst it appears better

quality/gravelly material has been chased around leaving varying mounds of partially extracted mineral. No apparent logical working method in this area. Undug mineral remaining on the lagoon side of the Phase.

- Lagoon situated between the Phase and conveyor run remains active.
- Within stockpiling area northern boundary now accommodates large volume of stocked gravel.
- Beyond the new bund created along northern edge of stockpiling area there stills needs to be clearance of material away from/and the hedge line tidied up.
- Remains of old machinery recorded in previous monitoring reports still in situ within the stocking ground.
- Southern end of stocking ground accommodating sand stock piles around screener plant and its radial arms.
- On far eastern side of site adjacent the water body a number of smaller sand stockpiles with a powerscreen to their south remains in place. The need for using this area was previously raised with BA and the potential for pulling back the active quarry boundary.
- Old float/platform lying between the stocking area and water body in north east corner remain.
- Processing plant area plant producing various grades with mainly gravel stocks being produced. .
- Concrete batching plant operational with one mixer truck observed.
- As per last visit request: Would it be possible to arrange when surveyor next on site for the boundary between "active" and "signed off land" to be demarcated on ground?
